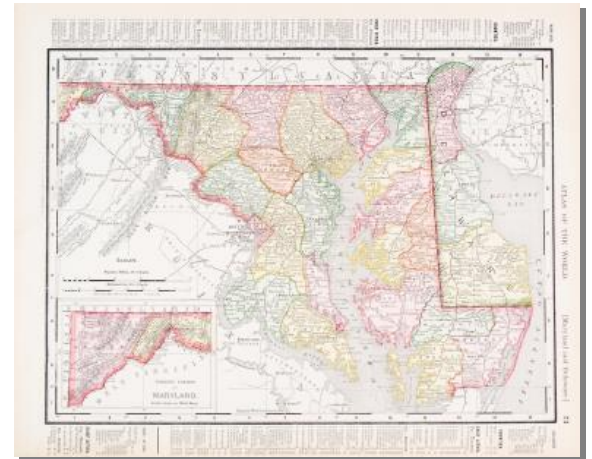
Social Security Contributes Billion\$ to Maryland's Economy

In Maryland there are **936,372** Social Security beneficiaries, including:

- 647,917 Retired Workers
- 130,696 Disabled Workers
- 61,429 Widow(er)s
- 31,587 Spouses
- 64,743 Children

Social Security benefits provide \$14 Billion Each year to Maryland's economy
