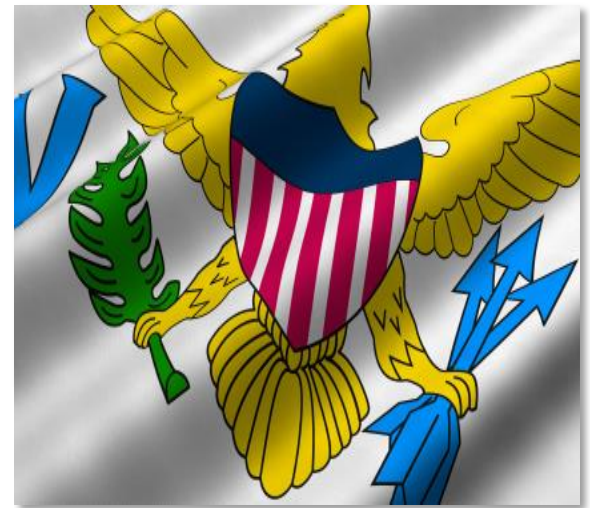
## Social Security Contributes Million\$ to U.S. Virgin Islands Economy

- 1,719 Children
